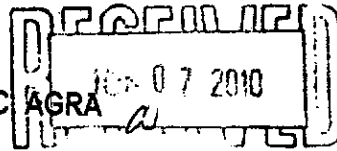

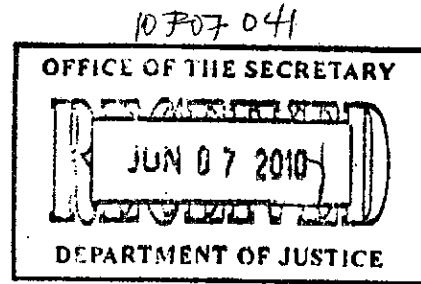

The Civil Service Commission, in its Announcement No. 29, s. 2010 dated May 5, 2010, has announced the **Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy (LKYSPP) Master in Public Management (MPM)** scholarship of the National University of Singapore (NUS) for academic calendar 2011.

The Master in Public Management (MPM) is an exclusive one-year full time programme targeted for senior level executives with over ten years of leadership experience. It is designed to enhance the skills of senior officials who hold key positions in their organizations. The curriculum provides a broad strategic view of issues and an emphasis on management perspectives.

Candidates should, among others: be between 35 to 50 years old; have a minimum of ten (10) years working experience with a proven track record in leadership preferably in the area of policy making and public management; and have good command of the English language (minimum TOEFL score of 580 or IELTS band of 6.5).

The Programme offers one of the most generous scholarships globally with a value of S\$ 130,000 (approximately US\$ 100,000). It also offers a unique opportunity for the scholar to spend the first semester at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy and the second semester at the John F. Kennedy School of Government (KSG), Harvard University or School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA), Columbia University.
