Attached for your reference is the 18 July 2018 letter from the Department of Foreign Affairs' Office of United Nations and International Organizations (DFA-UNIO) transmitting a copy of Note Verbale SCA/13/18 (08) from the Secretariat of the United Nations (UN). The UN Secretariat is requesting Member States of the UN to recommend qualified individuals to serve on the Panel of Experts established pursuant to Resolution No. 1973 (2011) on Libya, subject to the extension of its mandate by the UN Security Council slated for October 2018.

Recommended candidates must possess a minimum of ten (10) years of "progressively responsible experience" in the fields of arms, armed groups, finance, international humanitarian law/armed groups, maritime, regional issues, and transport.

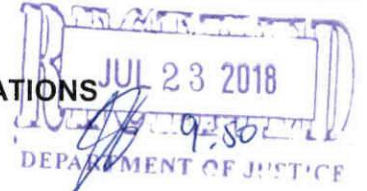
