SUBJECT : Call for Nomination to the Master in National Security Administration (MNSA), Regular Course No. 57, of the National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP)

Please be informed that the National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP) is now accepting nominees for the Master in National Security Administration (MNSA), Regular Course No. 57 for Academic Year 2021-2022, which will convene on 04 October 2021 until 15 September 2022, via blended learning modules.

Nominees/applicants must meet the following basic requirements to qualify for the MNSA scholarship Program: (i) must have a bachelor's degree; (ii) must be holding at least the position of Section Chief with salary grade 24 or its equivalent; (iii) must have at least ten (10) years of service in government (for appointed officials); (iv) must not be less than thirty-five (35) years old, but not more than fifty-five (55) years old upon admission; and (v) must be nominated by the Secretary of Justice.

All expenses for the MNSA scholarship Program will be shouldered by the NDCP, except for board and lodging, research and thesis writing, and week-long Global Security and Development Studies (GSDS) which will be shouldered by the DOJ based on the rate provided in the Contract of Commitment between the NDCP and DOJ.

Any interested applicants/nominees may submit their applications, together with the required documents, to the Office of the Secretary through the Training Section, this Department, not later than **05 March 2021**.
